Local History: Changing the Landscape of Vancouver

In 1983, EllisDon began the construction of Canada Harbour Place (now Canada Place) in Vancouver, British Columbia ("BC"). Completed in the spring of 1986 and serving as the host Pavilion for Expo that same year, Canada Harbour Place provided an anchor for the company's name on the West Coast. 40 years later, EllisDon has constructed and renovated over 100 facilities across the province, and they are only getting started.
